### GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Recreate a classic carnival game and challenge your family to play with you.

For this activity you'll need 5-10 tin cans (or you could substitute tin cans for drinks cans, bottles or other items). Using empty food cans such as baked bean and soup tins is ideal. Make sure you clean them out first. If you have time, you could also decorate the cans with paints or other craft materials.

Line the cans up on a table. You can either create a straight line or you could build a pyramid of cans. Set up a throwing line a couple of metres away. Pair some socks up to make sock balls.

Take turns to throw the balls and try to knock the cans off the table. Score a point for every can you knock off. You could write numbers on the cans, so different cans are worth different points. Which family member can score the most points?

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# **TOASTING MARSHMALLOWS**

**PREPARATION NEEDED** 





## GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Toast marshmallows over a flame or fire to create a tasty treat.

You'll need a heat source to toast your marshmallows. If you have a fire pit or similar, then use this. If not, use a disposable BBQ or try and create a small controlled fire in a foil tray using cotton wool, paper and carboard. A grown-up must assist with this.

If you can't create a fire, then try toasting marshmallows over the stove or a candle.

Place the marshmallow on the end of a skewer and hold it over the flame. Be careful not to get too close to the flame and abide by the safety advice from your grown-up. Once toasted, you can eat the marshmallow as it is, or place it between two digestive biscuits to create a s'more.

Ask a grown-up to take a photo of you toasting marshmallows and share it with your BB group or post on social media using #BBatHOME.

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# PIZZA **PORTRAITS**

### **GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY**

Get creative in the kitchen by creating a pizza designed to look like your face.

Use a wrap as your pizza base. Spread either tomato or BBQ sauce over the top and then sprinkle with cheese.

Now think about how you can use other toppings to make the pizza look like your face. You could use cut peppers as your face outline, salami as eyes, a mushroom as a nose, onion as eyebrows, sweetcorn for hair, mozzarella as your mouth. Be creative and think of imaginative ways to create your portrait using pizza toppings.

Once designed, place your pizza under the grill until the cheese is melted and the pizza looks ready to eat.

Before tucking into your pizza, ask a grown-up to take a photo of your pizza portrait and share it with your BB group or post on social media using #BBatHOME.

## **GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY**

We are often told that God loves us - but have you ever asked how much he loves us?

For this activity you'll need the worksheet at the bottom of this pack. If you don't have a printer, then you can make your own worksheet. Spend some time completing the measuring challenges. If you don't have a tape measure, you can measure distances using your feet or hands.

The last challenge asks how much God loves us. This is a trick question - God's love can't be measured! God loves you so much that no tape measure or timer will ever be able to measure that love. He loves you so much that he will always be there to look after and protect you. How good is that! Finish the activity in prayer, thanking God for all the love he gives you.

### **GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY**
