Sunday 7th November

Pray for that God's character and his promises to his people through Christ would move our hearts to genuinely confess our sins

Monday 8th November

Tuesday 9th November

Wednesday 10th November

Pray for those in our church family who are struggling with illness and bereavement. Pray for healing and comfort. Pray they 'look to the Lord and his strength: seek his face always.' 1 Chronicles 16:11

Thursday 11th November

Give thanks for all those who gave their lives so we can have peace. Pray those who grieve will be comforted. Pray for peace around the world and an end to conflict.

Friday 12th November

Pray for Christians who are persecuted. Pray for believers in Sudan as the military have launched a coup and there is renewed fear and uncertainty. Pray for peace and stability and for the country not to revert back to Islamic rule. Pray for Open Doors as they work with persecuted Christians.

Saturday 13th November

As we hear God's word preached today, pray we are encouraged to love him more and follow him closer. Pray we ponder on what we have heard over the following week and do not merely listen to the word but do what it says (James 1:22)
