The PCC met on **Thursday 21st July at 7.30pm**. The below are three headlines from the meeting:

- As we look to restructure church life around 5 core areas of ministry (Gather; Reach; All Nations; Care; Encourage) the first of three coordinators were appointed. These are Tom Rowe (Gather), Ian Singleton (Reach) and Bev Lean (Care).
- The PCC discussed the appointment of a full-time Families, Youth & Children's Worker from September 2023. To help make a decision, a potential job description was requested for the next PCC meeting.
- The PCC unanimously adopted the Church of England Evangelical Council's basis of faith and additional declarations as a helpful way of summarising what we believe as a church. These can now be found on our website.
